



How to Become a Registered License Not Required Child Care Provider (RLNR)

A RLNR child care provider is someone who can care for 2 unrelated children, or 1 sibling group in addition to their own children

Below are the Provincial requirements to register as a RLNR with the Child Care Resource & Referral Programs in BC.

- Be at least 19 years of age
- Complete a Self-Evaluation Form
- Complete an interview with the CCRR
- Complete a Provincial Criminal Record Review Check
- Submit 2 Character References
- Complete a First Aid course
- Undergo a Health & Safety Home Assessment
- Complete 20 hours of Family Child Care Training

RLNR Child Care Providers have access to all CCRR services including child care referrals, resources, consultations, newsletters, workshops and more! Eligible families in your care receive a higher rate of Affordable Child Care Benefit
